

Every Effort is being made to ensure our church is a safe environment. We are exceeding the minimum requirements from the CDC for places of Worship to be sure we are compliant. Here is what you can expect from us, and what you can do to help.

What WE Are Doing to provide a Safe Place for Worship:

1. Everything is being disinfected and cleaned before, during and after service.
2. We will have Volunteers stationed by the restrooms to clean and disinfect after each use.
3. We will have the Nursery open, but only for parents to stay with children as an “overflow”.
4. There will be no Kids Pointe.
5. Children can worship with us in the main sanctuary and have their tablet/phone and use headphones. We will provide wi-fi.
6. Safe Spacing with seats and in the sanctuary.
 - a. We will maintain the 6ft distancing with keeping 4 seats empty between families.
 - b. We will only seat every other row.
7. We will not be passing the Offering Buckets through the congregation for Offering.
 - a. We have our Tithe & Offering Slots on the foyer walls available.
 - b. We will have an additional box at the Info Center.
8. Taste & See is temporarily closed
9. We are strongly encouraging all our volunteers to wear masks and gloves.
10. Our Fellowship Time will be “With a Wave and a Smile”.
 - a. We will not have handshakes, hugs or high-fives during our 60 seconds of Fellowship.

What YOU Can Do to help provide a Safe Place for Worship:

- 1.) If you are over 65 yrs. old; consider worshipping from home
- 2.) If you, or anyone in your home has any underlying health conditions that increases your risk of getting the virus; please consider worshipping from home.
- 3.) If you are sick or have any symptoms or have been around anyone who has been sick, please worship with us from home.
- 4.) We encourage you to wear a mask when you come, but it is not required.
- 5.) Have your Tithes & Offering ready to give when you come in.
 - a. Put your Tithes & Offering in one of the designated boxes as you come in to service or as you leave after service.
- 6.) If you are bringing children in the service who may need to be occupied, you are welcome to bring tablets or phones with headphones.
- 7.) Only come if you are ready and when you feel safe!
 - a. We will still continue to have our livestream going during our Worship Service and you can always Worship with us from your home.
